

# Subject Pronouns

We use subject pronouns to replace the subject of the sentence. The subject is before the verb. The subject pronouns are *I, you* (singular), *he, she, it, we, you* (plural), and *they*.

## Instructions:

Circle the pronoun in the second sentence, or the second part of the sentence. In the first sentence, or the first part of the sentence, underline the noun the pronoun replaces.
